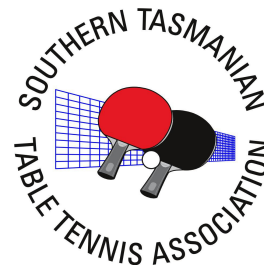

## Personal Details

Your personal details are entered on the STTTA database, securely stored, and only used for official STTTA purposes such as providing you with information relating to your indicated interests (rosters, championships, umpiring, social events etc.) and newsletters. Only your name, date of birth and postcode are provided to Table Tennis Australia (TTA). TTA issues your National ID number, which is required on all championship entry forms. Roster lists are on public display on the notice board in the table tennis stadium and only show your name and STTTA designated phone number (as given under 'Personal details'). Emergency contact and health details are also securely stored and are only accessible by STTTA officials or Kingborough Sports Centre (KSC) staff in the case of an emergency.

## Membership Categories

- Voting member\* person 18 years or older on 1 January 2017 wishing to compete in rosters
- Cadet member\* person under 18 years on 1 January 2017 wishing to compete in senior roster
- Junior member person under 18 years on 1 January 2017 wishing to compete in junior roster
- Social member person wishing to belong to STTTA but not competing in rosters

\* These memberships include TTA/TTTA annual registration charges. Registration is compulsory for all roster players (except for Junior rosters) and for any player entering an official open championship. Membership fees are for the full membership year and are not charged pro-rata. All membership categories include insurance. To meet insurance requirements, everyone who has played on more than three separate occasions in a calendar year in any capacity, including reserves, must take out membership of STTTA. Anyone joining for the sole purpose of entering a championship must pay the higher of voting membership or TTTA registration. Guest players who are financial members of an ITTF affiliated association (including insurance), must complete an application form and provide proof of registration. Membership cards are issued (except for juniors).

## Practice Passes

Practice passes can be purchased at any time and expire at the end of February. Practice passes may be used at any time the table tennis stadium is not reserved for club activities. Players receiving private coaching must hold a practice pass, as must the coach. Prices are based on the period in which they are issued, as follows:

Standard Passes include social membership. Discount Passes are for STTTA roster players who play in at least one complete roster or fill in at least 10 times as a reserve during the year (these players contribute financially through their roster fees). Family Passes are for up to four named members of the holder's immediate family. The holder of the Family Pass must be an adult. An adult must supervise children. Your player card will indicate whether you have a practice pass. A condition is that each time you practise, you must show your pass at the KSC front desk and record your name and pass number in the register.

## Conditions

- Change into clean non-marking soft-soled sports shoes in the stadium before walking on court. This is to prevent grit and small stones damaging the expensive Taraflex flooring. No food or drink allowed on court.
- You must sign in at the KSC front desk whenever you practise, *including Friday morning and Sunday afternoon official practice sessions*. Your name and practice pass number must be recorded in the register.
- If you have used the kitchen, leave it clean. When closing, all food is stored in the appropriate cupboard or fridge, the bin placed outside, chairs stacked outside the office and the office door locked by the last person to leave.
- Children are not to enter the office or control booth without permission.
- Do not use the robot unless you have been trained and authorised (unless under supervision by a coach).
- Report any damage or unacceptable behaviour to a Duty Officer, a Committee member, or the KSC front desk.
- Roster players must pay their nightly fee to the duty officer before 7.30pm. (Please also make any equipment purchases and pay memberships before 7.30.)
- Before leaving, remove litter and check for personal possessions. Return all equipment to the office.
- Last person to leave must turn off lights and advise KSC front desk that the stadium has been vacated.

*The Committee and roster organisers are all volunteers and rely on your cooperation and help.*
